ORDER APPOINTING SPECIAL CONSERVATOR AND AUTHORIZING DEPOSIT OF FUNDS INTO A UTMA ACCOUNT

A Minor.

The petition for approval of settlement for a minor having been considered, the Court finds:

- A.
