

How to Update Internet Explorer Compatibility View for a Website

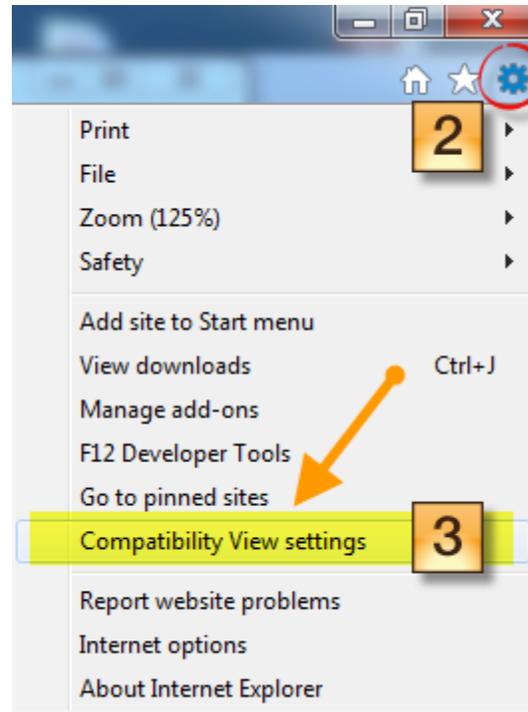
Many websites are designed to function using specific browsers like **Internet Explorer (IE)**. As newer versions of these browsers are released, some website pages might not display correctly in the newer versions (example versions: **IE8, IE9, IE10, or IE11**). When you turn on the **Compatibility View**  feature in the browser window, the webpage you're viewing, as well as any other webpage within that website's domain, will be displayed as if you were using the earlier version of Internet Explorer.

The following is one simple method to turn on the **Compatibility View** feature for our website <http://www.sc.pima.gov/>:

1. On the top left of the browser window taskbar displaying the webpage, look for the gear 



2. Click **Gear** to expand this menu
3. Click on **Compatibility View** settings



4. In the **Compatibility View Settings** window add website "*pima.gov*" if it did not automatically fill in
5. Click the **Add** button to drop the website into the box
6. Click **Close** and browser should automatically refresh to display results or repeat original calendar search for correct results
