



Mandatory Electronic Filing:

Electronic filing is now available in Pima County via AZTurboCourt for most civil actions.

- As of **April 20, 2015**, efilng is now mandatory for attorneys employed by a law firm, whose firm name begins with **letters A-M**, and for **all participants in the pilot project**.
- Commencing on **May 26, 2015**, it will become mandatory for attorneys employed by a law firm, whose name begins with **letters N-Z**, and for **solo practitioners**.

To begin efilng, you must first register with AZTurboCourt. Also, it is strongly recommended that you attend training via online training, live classes, and/or tutorial videos to fully understand the software.
