



Physical/Systemic/Sensory Disabilities

Persons requesting accommodations for a variety of physical and systemic conditions must submit documentation corresponding to the following:

- Documentation must originate from qualified evaluators who are properly trained for the condition involved (i.e. certified and/or licensed professionals such as medical doctors, neuropsychologists, audiologists, ophthalmologists, or appropriately trained rehabilitation specialists).
- Diagnosis of the condition and assessment of functional limitations for which accommodations are being requested.
- Degree and range of functioning for a chronic or progressive condition.
- Prescribed medications, dosages, and schedules which may influence the types of accommodations provided, including any possible side effects.
- Suggestions for reasonable accommodations must be accompanied by an expressed rationale.
- Documentation must be recent enough to represent current functioning and need for specific accommodations.
