Applications Being Accepted for Vacancies on Pima County Superior Court

Applications are being accepted for two vacancies on the Pima County Superior Court created by the retirement of Judge John Kelly and the appointment of Judge Virginia Kelly to Division II of the Arizona Court of Appeals.

The Pima County Commission on Trial Court Appointments will review applications, interview selected applicants and recommend at least three nominees for each vacancy to Governor Jan Brewer, who will appoint the new judges.

Applicants must be at least 30 years old, admitted to practice law in and a resident of Arizona for the past five years, and a resident of Pima County for the past year.

Applicants for the recent vacancy in Pima County must reapply to be considered for the new vacancies.

The original completed application and 16 copies must be returned to the Administrative Office of the Courts, Human Resources Division, 1501 W. Washington, Suite 221, Phoenix, AZ, 85007, by 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 13, 2010.

The Commission may, at its discretion, use the applications filed for these vacancies to nominate candidates for any additional vacancies known to the Commission before the screening meeting for these vacancies is held.

All meetings of the Pima County Commission on Trial Court Appointments are open to the public. Meeting dates will be announced next month. The new judges will be paid \$145,000 annually.
