**Public Comment Sought on Candidates for
Superior Court Judge *Pro Tempore* Vacancy**

The public is being asked for comments on eight applicants to fill a vacancy created on the Pima County Superior Court Bench by the retirement of Judge *Pro Tempore* Hon. Frank Dawley.

The Nominating Committee reviewed 29 applications received for the judge *pro tempore* position and selected 8 to be interviewed. The applicants to be interviewed are: Michelle C. Araneta, Raquel Arellano, Sylvia E. Goodwin, Shawn A. Jensvold, Richard B. Jones, Danelle B. Liwski, Jose H. Robles, and Pamela A. Treadwell-Rubin.

The interviews will be held on Sept. 14, 2009, at the Superior Court Building, 110 W.
