



## YOUR SAFETY AND SECURITY WHEN VISITING THE COURTHOUSE AND COURT OFFICES

### Tips for visiting the Superior and Juvenile courthouses and court facilities

- **DO NOT COME TO COURT IF YOU ARE SICK.** If you or a family member are ill, please contact your attorney or the [Judicial Division](#) hearing your matter. Your proceeding may be rescheduled to another date, or you may be asked to appear telephonically.
- **Bring and wear your mask or face covering!** The public will not be permitted inside a court building without a covering over their nose and mouth.
- **Be prepared to have a wellness check.** Courthouses and court offices are conducting temperature checks upon entry, using touchless thermometers. If you have a temperature of 100.4 or higher you will not be permitted inside a court building.
- **Many hearings are being conducted telephonically.** Please make sure that you must appear for your hearing before you visit the courthouse.
- **Do not bring your friends and family,** unless they are critical to the proceeding. Most non-litigants will not be permitted in the courtroom during hearings.
- **Please review the list of [court prohibited items](#)** and do not bring them with you.
- **Please limit the materials and personal items** you bring to the courthouse.
- **Please observe the instructions of posted signs** regarding social distancing – the guidelines are for your safety and the safety of everyone visiting or working in the courthouse.
- **Please follow the direction** of court security personnel.
- And finally, when possible, **please delay discretionary and non-essential proceedings.**

### Access to the downtown Superior Courthouse (110 W Congress)

- **Please enter through the west entrance** (adjacent to the Pima County Administration building) the east entrance is temporarily closed.
