▶ **NOTE: Minors are encouraged to arrive between 7:00 am and 7:30 am to expedite the sign in process. ◀**

- **Wear appropriate work clothing:** Work will include various outdoor tasks, including painting. Wear appropriate clothing. – dress for weather conditions and prepare for paint damage to clothing. Sleeveless shirts, tank tops, “short” shorts (more than 4” above the knee), sandals or open-toed shoes are **not** allowed. Overalls must be buttoned up (both front and back). Pants must be worn with the belt-line at waist level, and cuffs must be off the ground. No bandannas may be worn, and baseball or other hats must be worn forward. Any clothing which may indicate gang affiliation or displays drugs or alcoholic beverages, topics of a sexual nature, or violent or negative messages is prohibited. Minimize jewelry and personal items.
- **Protective gear will be provided as needed** – gloves, safety goggles, back brace, safety vests, etc.
- **Bring a sack lunch:** Beverages are optional. Beverages must be in non-glass containers. A cooler is available.
- **Transportation should be arranged to and from C.R.E.W.:** Pickup and drop-off should be prompt. Bring change for the bus.
- **Bring and present any medications** to C.R.E.W. staff, with a note from your parent/guardian or probation officer. Medications must be the original prescription bottle, with both the name of the medication and the name of the minor present on the bottle. Any medication will be held by C.R.E.W. staff during program hours. Sun screen is provided, but participants may bring their own sun screen.

Do NOT bring pagers, cellular phones, matches, lighters, cigarettes, pens, pencils, markers, etching tools, walkman or other radio/tape/CD-type players, candy or gum.

- **Appropriate behavior and attitude are expected while participating in the C.R.E.W. program.** Participants will be advised of program rules and requirements during sign-in. Failure to maintain acceptable conduct and/or work effort will result in deduction of credited community service hours. If necessary, follow up will be made with the assigned Probation Officer, possibly leading to termination from C.R.E.W. participation and appropriate court action.
