Whereas Rule 1.3 of the Pima County Local Rules of Practice provides that Law and Motion Day shall be on Mondays or as otherwise ordered by the court;

Whereas Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2020-197 also provides that local Presiding Judges may adopt or suspend any local rule as needed to address the current public health emergency;

Whereas case processing and scheduling in the court currently necessitates that Law and Motion day be moved to Fridays;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Law and Motion Day in Pima County Superior Court shall be every Friday until further order of the court. If Friday is a holiday, Law and Motion Day shall be conducted the next court business day thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the effective date of this Administrative Order shall be February 1, 2021. This Order shall remain in full force and effect until or unless amended, modified or vacated.
