Family Drug Court (FDC) is a **voluntary** program for parents presenting with substance abuse problems whose children are in the legal custody of the Department of Child Safety (DCS). FDC provides extra support and accountability while parents are working on their recovery from addiction to drugs (including prescription drugs) and/or alcohol.

If you were asked to observe an FDC session, please review the schedule located on the back. Once you have observed and received your observation certificate, you decide whether or not the FDC program is the right fit for you.

How will Family Drug Court benefit you?

You will receive:

- Specialized parenting classes that include time with your child in most cases
- ♦ A Recovery Support Specialist, who has their own experience in recovery and will see you every week and help you with your case plan.
- Weekly (that eventually goes down to monthly) appearances before the FDC
 Judge
- ♦ An on-site DCS case manager in the dedicated FDC Unit for you and your children
- ♦ Trauma screening and referral for trauma-focused therapy
