UPDATE SEPTEMBER 1, 2020

Most appointments and classes through Conciliation Court are taking place telephonically or through an online video platform.

- **Necessary paperwork must be completed and returned well before your scheduled appointment.**

- The Legal Services building, where Conciliation Court is located, is not open to the public at this time.

Family observation, child interviews and home visit appointments

- The Conciliation Court has temporarily postponed evaluation-related family observations and home visit appointments. However, it is accepting referrals for limited scope assessments which will include the following: parent intakes; an acquisition of, and review of records; and child interview, if age appropriate, with a report in the form of a summary of involvement.
 - The summary may include limited clinical recommendations, if appropriate, according to Conciliation Court, given the limited scope of involvement
- **As of June 1, 2020, ARFLP (Rule 12) child interview appointments have resumed.** Appointments are being held in the Superior Courthouse on the 2nd floor, courtroom 222.
 - **Individuals scheduled to bring their children for an interview should contact the Conciliation Court at 520-724-5590 or fccc@sc.pima.gov for questions regarding their appointment.**

Parent Education Classes

- Effective July 8, 2020, Conciliation Court is providing parent education classes remotely via a video platform, Microsoft Teams.
 - In-person parent education classes are suspended until further notice.
- Individuals needing to complete a parent education class should contact the Conciliation Court at 520-724-5590 or fccc@sc.pima.gov to schedule their appointment.
 - Parties must pay a \$45.00 parent education fee with the Clerk of Court's office at the time of filing.
- Effective July 1, 2020, parties are required to submit a written motion to take a parent education class other than that provided by Conciliation Court.
- **All parties who take an online parent education class must file their certificate of completion with the Clerk's office.**
