



Public Comment Sought on Candidates for Judge Pro Tempore Vacancy

The Arizona Superior Court in Pima County is asking for comments regarding six applicants for a Judge Pro Tempore vacancy on its bench. The position became available upon the appointment of the Hon. Kimberly H. Ortiz to Superior Court Judge by Governor Doug Ducey.

This position is responsible for presiding over various criminal cases. While the selected applicant will be appointed a standard criminal caseload, an assignment to a problem-solving specialty court may be required.
